Welcome to CS 152! Throughout the course, your programming assignments will require you to create an IntelliJ project, follow instructions from both the assignment pdf and in line comments, and finally, only turn in the required .java file or files. Throughout your computer science career, you must write well-formatted code without errors. In this assignment, you will practice all these skills and answer pertinent questions about lab.

1. Create an IntelliJ project.

You can create an IntelliJ project by launching the application. Note you can see the file path for your project when you name your project.

2. Add the provided .java file.

Download and add the provided file to your src directory; this is located within your IntelliJ project.

3. Follow the TODO comments at the top of the file.

These comments start with “TODO” and IntelliJ color codes them to green. These comments document what still needs finishing within a program. Make sure to delete all these comments, so your final code is clean and well-formatted.

4. Turn in the edited file into Canvas.
