

Lab 1: Your Name in Turtle Graphics



Use NetLogo Turtle Graphics to draw your first name. You may draw in simple block letters or a stylized letters - so long as your name is readable. You may augment your name with decorations drawn in turtle graphics.

[2 points]: The first few lines of your program are comments including your name, the date and a description of what your program does.

[2 points]: Your program includes a comment at the start of the drawing of each letter - telling which letter that part of the code is drawing.

[5 points]: When run, the code uses turtle graphics to draw your first name.

[5 points]: Your program draws your name (and any decorations) using at least 5 different colors. This does not mean you need to draw your name 5 times (although you may do so). You can make each letter in a different color or parts of letters in different colors.

[4 points]: Your program draws your name (and any decorations) using at least 20 different turtle moves.
